Dear Students and Teachers,

Please accept my apology for the changes made in Lesson 4, Section 4.6, regarding the single-word switch indicator. A final decision has been made that a HYPHENATED COMPOUND WORD is considered to be one word in this context. Therefore, the single-word switch indicator may be used for a hyphenated compound word between two Nemeth expressions. The next update to Lesson 4 will explain and illustrate. For now, PLEASE DELETE the last sentence in Section 4.6.3 ("A hyphenated word is considered to be more than one word.") and ALSO DELETE Example 4.6-7 ("Normal human body temperature is 98.6 plus-or-minus 0.6 degrees.").
